The work is scheduled to begin July 8, 2024 and conclude late October

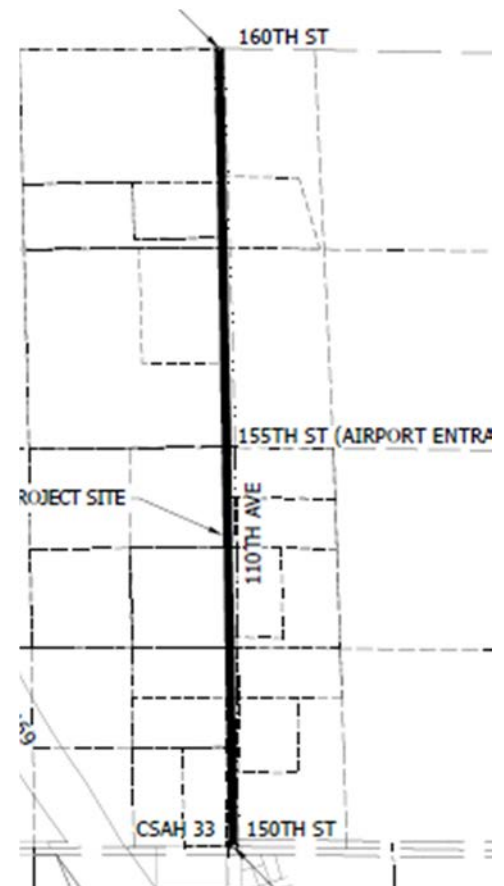
The Prime Contractor for the project is Northern Lines Contracting, Inc., The City appreciates your cooperation and patience during this important project.
